Woodcut title page rather defective inner lower margin and round edges (NAT). 4 volumes in one. Double columns. Columns numbered two to a page. 8+436; 6+958; 2+636; 4+714+index etc. Half title to volumes. Possibly wanting a leaf in the Preface to the whole? Minor wear, stains etc but generally quite good. Contemporary full calf, defective on spine with some loss. Joints weak. *Adams 1167 which itself only calls for the four introductory leaves as above copy. Cicero was one of the greatest Orators of antiquity. Born circa 107 BC, Mark Anthony had him beheaded in BC 43.* £450/\$765
