Undated title pages to both volumes. In excellent crisp tear free condition with wide margins (2”). Scattered minor browning or soiling negligible. Contemporary blind stamped vellum over wooden boards with loss of vellum above top band of spine. Adams B 1999. *Gabriel Biel: German Philosopher and theologian. Died 1495. There is a dated title page to ‘A Looking Glasse for Drunkards’. Distorted contents loose in vellum binding. Minor early and late wear to edges. Corners very slightly worn or curled. One or two small marginal blemishes else quite a good copy.
