A little early worming lower base outside column of text which starts as a hole, widens into a line, and disappears abruptly about the 60th page. Very few small holes last leaf or two also. Complete and in mainly very good condition. Contemporary or early vellum backed boards. A few blemishes or splits on spine. *A papal commentary on the collection of letters of Popes first brought into use in the 9th century and subsequently used to bolster Papal power against the Bishops.
